Notice of Privacy Practices

Our Commitment to Your Privacy

DFW Surgical Partners is committed to protecting the privacy and confidentiality of your medical information. This Notice describes how your medical information may be used and disclosed, and how you can access this information. We are required by law to maintain the privacy of your Protected Health Information (PHI) and to provide you with this notice of our legal duties and privacy practices.

How We May Use and Disclose Your Information

We may use and disclose your medical information for treatment, payment, and healthcare operations.

Treatment: To provide, coordinate, or manage your care.

Payment: To bill and collect payment for services.

Healthcare Operations: For administrative, training, quality improvement (QAPI), and accreditation purposes.

Other Uses and Disclosures

We may disclose your information as required by law, for public health activities, health oversight activities, law enforcement, emergency situations, and workers' compensation.

Uses Requiring Your Authorization

We will not use or disclose your health information for marketing purposes, sale of your information, or certain psychotherapy notes without your written authorization. You may revoke your authorization at any time in writing.

Your Rights Regarding Your Health Information

You have the right to access your records, request corrections, request restrictions, request confidential communications, receive an accounting of disclosures, and obtain a paper copy of this Notice.

Our Responsibilities

We are required to maintain the privacy of your health information, provide this Notice, follow its terms, and notify you in the event of a breach.

Changes to This Notice

We reserve the right to update this Notice at any time. Updates will be posted with a revised effective date.
